What we do

We're a small, forward thinking charity working with local partners to make sure Syrian communities have the medical care and education they need, every day and when emergencies strike.

Since the conflict began, we've raised over **£8 million** for humanitarian aid. December 2024 marked an extraordinary shift in Syria with the fall of the Assad regime. While there is optimism, recent violence has shown how fragile this moment is.

The humanitarian needs remain staggering. Today, **16.7 million** people need humanitarian assistance, **90%** of the population lives in poverty, and **2 million** Syrian refugee children are out of school.

In Syria's new phase post the Assad regime, we're working with our local partners to respond where support is needed most. As Syrians begin to rebuild, we're here for as long as we're needed.

Who we help

Right now, we're providing education to over 80 Syrian refugee children and rehabilitating schools in rural Damascus. We're raising funds to sustain these programmes, as well as restart our prosthetics clinic and primary health centre in northern Syria. We also mobilise when there is an emergency, such as an earthquake or bombing.

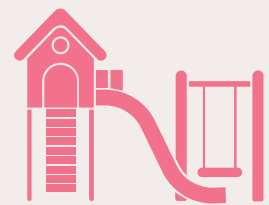

Action Syria Carols is our annual flagship fundraiser — an unforgettable evening of candlelit carols, celebrity readings, and live performances from Syrian and UK artists. The night ends with a drinks reception and a Middle Eastern feast by Toum & Tahini, all set in the breath-taking surroundings of St Bartholomew the Great, London's oldest surviving church.

This event brings together influential voices in support of Syrian communities who, after over a decade of conflict and displacement, are working towards a brighter future.

In 2024, we welcomed **500+ guests**, raised over **£80,000**, and reached **20,000+** online. This year, we aim to raise **£90,000** — and we need sponsors to help us get there.

With the fall of the Assad regime, Syrians are returning home, rebuilding, and reconnecting. But millions still face poverty, displacement, and shrinking international aid.
